**NOTICE FOLLOW BY MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER
(PERINTAH KAWALAN PERGERAKAN) EXTENDED TO APRIL 14**

The Government of Malaysia has observed an increase of new Covid-19 positive cases due to the pandemic. Therefore, on March 25, 2020, our Prime Minister had made an announcement to extend the movement control order (MCO) until 14th April 2020. In accordance with the relevant government action, EMPTA hereby would like to inform all our members the followings :-

- (1) For our own safety and fulfilling our social obligations, members are advised to adhere to the Government directive and temporarily stop your respective company operations or shop from 1st to 14th April 2020.
- (2) However, the Kuala Lumpur Federal Territory and the Selangor state government has allowed certain industries to continue to operate at the particular time. But the Majlis Keselamatan Negara has not set a clear directive on which industry are allowed to operate, therefore we advise all members to temporarily suspend your business operation. Should you decide to carry on your business operation, it will be under your own discretion and risks. (In the other word, you have to bear all the responsibility yourself).
- (3) Please inform us (by writing in before 31 Mac 2020) the difficulties faced by the members during the MCO period and e-mail to info@empta.org.my or by **WhatsApp to 012-2671407** . We will list them out and forward to the relevant government departments for immediate action.
